• Dr. Dawn Wright will speak to the class. Dr. Wright is a professor of Geography and Oceanography at OSU, where she has been on the faculty since 1995. Prior to joining the OSU faculty, she was a seagoing marine technician for the international Ocean Drilling Program and a post-doctoral research associate at the NOAA Pacific Marine Environmental Laboratory in Newport, Ore.

#### ON THE FIELD

- Men's Basketball hosts Cal Thursday at 7:30 p.m. and Stanford Saturday at Noon. Both games are nationally televised on FSN. The team won at Arizona Saturday - the first time for an OSU win in Tucson since 1983.
- · Women's Basketball is at the Bay Area schools this weekend. The Beavers play at California Thursday night (7 p.m.) and at Stanford Saturday (7 p.m.).
- · Baseball, ranked as high as 10th in the major polls, opens its 2010 season Friday night at Hawaii. The Beavers play four games in Honolulu before returning to Corvallis.
- No. 3 (as of this week) Gymnastics posted a season-high score last week vs. Arizona. It's the highest ranking for the Beavers since they were No. 3 on March 30, 1992. They travel to face No. 9 UCLA on Sunday in the first of four straight

meets on the road against Top 25 teams.

- No. 14 Wrestling finished the regular season at 18-3. The team will be at the Pac-10 Championships late next week.
- Softball is at a tournament at Texas A&M starting Friday. The Beavers play Lousiana-Monroe, Texas A&M and Mississippi State over five games. Mary Clair Brenner set a school record with three home runs against Southern Utah to cap off a 2-3 weekend last week for the Beavers.
- Natonally ranked Men's Golf is currently competing at the Battle of the Beach in Newport Beach, Calif. Diego Velasquez has been named one of 25 individuals to the Ben Hogan Award "Watch List." Diego was the No. 2 ranked player in the country following the fall season.
- Women's Golf opens the spring season Sunday at the Island Classic in South Carolina.
- For the first time since 1988, male student-athletes competed in track -- at the Husky Classic. Football's Jordan Bishop won the high jump.
- · Women's Track's miler Laura Carlyle set a school record in winning the mile at the Husky Classic Saturday. Carlyle posted a 4:50.90 finish, edging out Roxanne Sellick of Fresno State by .65 both in her section and overall.
- Ephraim "Red" Rocha, a 1947 OSU basketball All-American and legendary coach at Hawai'i passed away Friday at the age of 86. He is also a member of the OSU Hall of Fame, Hawai'i Hall of Fame and Pac-10 Hall of Honor.
- Three former Oregon State student-athletes will be honored Monday at the San Diego Hall Of Champions' 64th Annual Salute to the Champions Dinner. Women's Basketball's Mercedes Fox-Griffin, Football's Sean Canfield and Baseball's Ryan Ortiz will be recognized as Breitbard Stars of the Month at some point in 2009.
