James Nygren and Matt Boyd combined to limit Hawaii to five hits in a shutout of the Rainbows Monday night as the Beavers concluded their trip with a 5-0 victory at Les Murakami Stadium. The victory gave Oregon State a 3-1 series victory over Hawaii on the opening weekend of the 2010 season.

First Of 34

The game Friday night is the first of the season at home for the Beavers, where they will play 34 of 57 games this season. The 34 games at Goss Stadium marks a single-season record for the Beavers, whose previous high at home was 31 in both 2005 and 2006.

Third Papé Grand Slam

- The Tennessee series marks the fourth straight season the Beavers will play at least one regular season game against a Southeastern Conference school.
- OSU relievers combined to go 2-1 with a 1.06 ERA in the series at Hawaii. They threw 17.0 innings, scattering 10 hits and two earned runs while striking out 16. Hawaii hit just .172.
- Oregon State has won its last six home openers. The Beavers are 13-2 under Pat Casey in home openers.
- The Beavers have won 14 consecutive non-conference home games dating back to the 2008 season.
- Former Beaver Kevin Gunderson will throw out the first pitch at Saturday's game. Joe Paterson is slated to do so on Sunday.
- OSU was 11-3 in home night games in 2009.

Waldron was a 32nd round selection in the 2007 MLB First-Year Player Draft by Florida.

2010 (Junior)

Served as the opening-day starter for the Beavers and went 4 1/3 innings, striking out seven while allowing six runs - one earned - and five hits at Hawaii (2/19).

2009 (Sophomore)

Went 6-4 in 16 appearances, including 14 starts ... Posted an ERA of 4.15 in 93 1/3 innings ... Struck out 70 while walking just 31 ... Took the loss against TCU after allowing nine hits and six runs in 4 1/3 innings (5/30) ... Finished the regular season by holding Stanford to five hits and two runs with five strikeouts in 6 2/3 innings (5/24) ... Won his fifth game of the season after scattering five hits and no runs in 7 1/3 innings against Oregon (5/19) ... Went a full nine against Gonzaga, scattering two hits and a run in a win (5/12) ... Took the loss after allowing 10 hits and six runs in five innings at UCLA (4/24) ... Picked up his first loss in more than a month despite allowing five hits and four runs over seven innings against USC (4/17) ... Did not figure in the decision after allowing 11 hits and five runs over six innings against Arizona (4/9) ... Worked 7 2/3 innings against California, allowing eight hits and four runs to pick up his third win of the season (4/3) ... Picked up his second straight win after allowing just one run and five hits over 7 1/3 innings against Oregon (3/27) ... Earned his first career Oregon State victory, going eight innings, allowing three hits and three walks while striking out six against Utah Valley (3/19) ... Took the loss after allowing eight hits and seven runs in five innings against Oklahoma State (3/6) ... Struck out six and allowed five hits and three runs but did not figure in the decision against Arizona State (2/28).

Pacific

Played one season for Pacific, located in Stockton, Calif. ... Went 3-7 in 2008, posting a 5.20 earned run average ... Started all 15 games he appeared in and worked a team-leading 91 2/3 innings ... Struck out 63 ... Appeared against Oregon State in the final game of the season, and limited the Beavers to just five hits and two runs over seven innings while striking out five.

Golden Sierra High

During his tenure at Golden Sierra, was a four-year all-league performer and two-time Most Valuable Player for the Grizzlies ... Was also named the Sacramento Player of the Year in 2007 ... Posted a 0.65 earned run average as a senior, allowing just seven earned runs in 76 innings ... Finished with 151 strikeouts to just 17 walks as a senior ... Offensively, as a senior, hit .530 with 12 doubles, two triples and two home runs ... Had a 7-2 record and 1.13 ERA as a junior.
