Last Game

Tyler Smith and Adalberto Santos each hit solo home runs and Matt Boyd allowed one run over 6 1/3 innings as the 18th-ranked Oregon State baseball swept its four-game series with Maine with a 2-1 victory Sunday at Goss Stadium at Coleman Field. Smith's and Santos' home runs were solo and came in the Beavers' two-run third. Boyd lasted 6 1/3 innings, allowing four hits and a run while striking out four.

A Cure For What Ails You

Oregon State came into the Maine series with a .243 batting average. The Beavers improved that to .268 after hitting .343 over the four-game series. OSU collected 13 doubles and seven home runs in the series.

On The Other End

OSU was able to lower its ERA to 2.73, as well. The Beavers finished with an ERA of 2.50 over the weekend as Maine batted just .195, totaling 26 hits, only nine of which were extra bases.

- The Beavers are 4-1 in one-run games this season, including 4-0 at home. OSU was 6-7 overall in one-run games last season.
- OSU's starters have eight quality starts through the first 17 games this season. The Beavers had 16 in all of 2009.
- The Beavers are 19-1 in non-conference home games dating back to the 2009 season.
- OSU has scored 32 runs in the third this season, compared to just three by its opponents.
