Michael Miller hit his first career home run and Ryan Ortiz drove in three hits on the strength of a 2-for-4 night in an 8-4 victory over BYU on Tuesday. The win gave the Beavers a sweep of the two-game midweek series. Miller parked a three-run home run in the second to start OSU's scoring and Tanner Robles, Ryan Gorton and James Nygren held the BYU bats quiet enough for the four-run victory.

Call Him Mr. Ortiz, Thank You

On March 15, Ryan Ortiz's batting average was .224 after an 0-for-4 game against Missouri State. Entering the opener against USC, Ortiz is batting .354, having raised it 130 points in the span of 16 games. He has hit safely in 15 of those games, running hit streaks of seven and eight games, respectively. He is currently on an eight-gamer.

Is It A Coincidence?

During Ortiz's 16-game hitting tear, the Beavers have gone 14-2. The only two games they lost came by one run each time.

After 29 games last season, OSU was 17-12. This year, the Beavers are 22-7.

Notes Of Importance

- Oregon State's 14-2 record over the last 16 games is the best stretch for the Beavers since they went 14-2 early in the 2007 season.
- Michael Miller finished the BYU series 3-for-6 with a home run and five RBI. He came into the two-game series with seven RBI on the year.
- Oregon State pitchers have amassed an earned run average of 2.72 over the last 16 games. Opponents are batting just .223 against them while Oregon State hitters are at a .286 clip.
- Entering the week, OSU's (then) ERA of 3.67 was ranked 10th nationally. After the two BYU games, it was raised by .05 runs.
- The Beavers also ranked 18th nationally in fielding percentage at .974.
- Friday's starter, Tyler Waldron, has allowed just four runs in 15 2/3 innings (2.30 ERA) at home this season. Friday is his third start at Goss in 2009.

Struck out six and allowed five hits and three runs but did not figure in the decision against Arizona State (2/28) ... Made his first Oregon State appearance, striking out four while allowing six hits in 5.0 innings against Tennessee (2/21).

Played one season for Pacific, located in Stockton, Calif. ... Went 3-7 in 2008, posting a 5.20 earned run average ... Started all 15 games he appeared in and worked a team-leading 91 2/3 innings ... Struck out 63 ... Appeared against Oregon State in the final game of the season, and limited the Beavers to just five hits and two runs over seven innings while striking out five.

Golden Sierra High

During his tenure at Golden Sierra, was a four-year all-league performer and two-time Most Valuable Player for the Grizzlies ... Was also named the Sacramento Player of the Year in 2007 ... Posted a 0.65 earned run average as a senior, allowing just seven earned runs in 76 innings ... Finished with 151 strikeouts to just 17 walks as a senior ... Offensively, as a senior, hit .530 with 12 doubles, two triples and two home runs ... Had a 7-2 record and 1.13 ERA as a junior ... During the summer of 2006 he was a member of the Milwaukee Brewers Area Code Team.
