The Game

Oregon State and Washington State open their three-game series Friday night in Pullman. First pitch from Bailey-Brayton Field is scheduled for 5:30 p.m. PT.

Radio

The game will not be televised. The second game of the series, on Saturday, will be televised live on FSN Northwest beginning at 2 p.m. PT.

Last Game

Adalberto Santos and Danny Hayes both hit home runs but the 18th-ranked Oregon State baseball team lost the series finale to Stanford, 10-7, Sunday afternoon at Goss Stadium. Santos and Hayes hit their home runs in the seventh and ninth innings, respectively, as the Beavers scored six runs over the final four innings, but it was too little to overcome Stanford's early lead. The Cardinal scored three runs in the second and six in the third for a 9-1 lead after the Beavers opened the game with a solo run in the first.

Romero's Streak

Stefen Romero comes into the game with the second-longest hitting streak of the season by a Beaver. He is on a seven-gamer and is 8-for-31 (.258) during it.

Home Runs

The Beavers hit two home runs - one apiece by Adalberto Santos and Danny Hayes - in the loss Sunday, giving OSU 21 and just two shy of last season's overall total. The Beavers are on pace for 37 this season.

- Stefen Romero has reached base safely in 23 consecutive games and in 29 of 30 games overall this season. His only game in which he failed to do so was Feb. 28 against Tennessee.
- OSU has played in front of an average of 1,874 fans per game, including 15 of 2,000 or more.
- Oregon State has lost five consecutive games, its longest such streak since losing seven straight in 2004.

Peavey was a 32nd round selection in the 2009 MLB First-Year Player Draft by Houston ... He was also selected in the 24th round of the 2007 MLB Draft by the New York Yankees.

2010 (Junior)

Allowed 10 hits and five runs in 6 1/3 innings against Stanford but did not earn a decision (4/16) ... Threw his second complete game of the season, scattering just two hits and a run while striking out six to get the win against No. 3 UCLA (4/9) ... Went seven full innings against USC, but did not pick up the decision after allowing three hits, a run, three walks and 10 strikeouts (4/1) ... Scattered four hits and a run in 4 2/3 innings against Long Beach State, but was removed before earning the win due to a rain delay (3/26) ... Picked up his second win after limiting Maine to six hits and two runs over six innings (3/19) ... Allowed five hits and four runs over 6 1/3 innings against Utah but did not get the decision (3/13) ... Threw his first career complete-game shutout, holding Tennessee to three hits while striking out nine for the win (2/28) ... Limited Hawaii to four hits and three runs over 5.0 innings, but did not get the decision (2/21).
