Last Game

The Oregon State baseball team dropped a 9-4 decision to No. 17 Oregon in a non-conference game Tuesday night at PK Park. Andrew Susac supplied Oregon State with its main highlight offensively, hitting the first pitch he saw from Oregon reliever Madison Boer over the left-center fence. It was his first career long ball. All told, the Beavers rapped out 10 hits to 11 for Oregon, with Stefen Romero pacing the club with three – including two doubles – and Adalberto Santos totaling two to extend his hit streak to six games.

Romero Lately

Stefen Romero has hit well as of late, posting a .429 batting average (9-for-21) over his last five games. He has two doubles and a home run with three RBI over that stretch.

Home Runs

Andrew Susac hit his first career home run Tuesday and in doing so, gave the Beavers 23 home runs as a team this season, tying their mark from all of last season.

Six-Gamer

Adalberto Santos is 9-for-26 (.346) during his six-game hit streak.

- Santos is the only Beaver to start at the same position in all 35 games this season, doing so in center field.
- Friday's starter, Greg Peavey, has thrown five quality starts this season, and in three of his last four games.
- Peavey, however, will be looking for his first win since April 9 when he two-hit No. 3 UCLA.
- The Beavers are 3-2 on the road when scoring first and 5-2 away from Goss when limiting opponents to five runs or less.
- OSU was 24-11 through 35 games in 2009.

Threw a quality start, but took the loss after allowing nine hits and three earned runs in seven innings against Washington State (4/23) ... Allowed 10 hits and five runs in 6 1/3 innings against Stanford but did not earn a decision (4/16) ... Threw his second complete game of the season, scattering just two hits and a run while striking out six to get the win against No. 3 UCLA (4/9) ... Went seven full innings against USC, but did not pick up the decision after allowing three hits, a run, three walks and 10 strikeouts (4/1) ... Scattered four hits and a run in 4 2/3 innings against Long Beach State, but was removed before earning the win due to a rain delay (3/26) ... Picked up his second win after limiting Maine to six hits and two runs over six innings (3/19) ...
