Tyler Waldron scattered two hits and a run over nine full innings as the Beavers opened the mid-week series with an 8-1 win over Gonzaga on Tuesday night. Carter Bell hit his first career home run in the eighth, part of a six-run inning that cushioned the Beavers in their seven-run win. Waldron struck out eight in the team's first complete game in 2009. Brent Warren also had a three-run double in the eighth.

### All-Time Against Washington State

The Beavers and Cougars have played 410 times entering the series, which is the most all-time for the Beavers against any opponent. OSU's 188 wins is second-most, behind only 222 over Washington.

Sunday is Senior Day. Oregon State will honor John Wallace, Koa Kahalehoe, Kyle Foster, Mark Grbavac and Logan Boyd.

### 8-1 Win Equals 30 Victories This Season

- Both Carter Bell and Brent Warren had their first multiple-RBI games of their careers Tuesday, both driving in three runs in the eighth.
- Carter Bell's home run Tuesday was the team's 16th of the season. Of the 16 hit this season, 10 have come from players who are in their first year with the team.
- OSU's 15 wins at home this season gives the Beavers 101 at Goss over the last five seasons.
- OSU is 2-4 in its last six against the Cougars. Prior to that, OSU had won seven straight. OSU won nine straight in the series from 2001-02.

Made his fourth appearance of the year, scattering four hits and a run over three innings against BYU (4/14) ... Worked three innings against UC Riverside, walking four and allowing one hit (3/7) ... Scattered two hits and three runs in four innings against Missouri (3/7) ... Served as Oregon State's opening day starter and allowed three hits and three runs over five innings at Tennessee (2/20).

#### 2008 (Freshman)

Finished his first campaign with OSU with a 3-2 record and 6.31 ERA ... Made 10 appearances, eight of which were starts ... Worked 35 2/3 innings, striking out 28 while opponents hit .219 against him ... Was 2-1 with a 6.65 ERA in six Pac-10 appearances ... Dropped to 3-2 on the year after allowing seven hits and six runs in two innings against Long Beach State (5/19) ... Started against UCLA and did not get a decision after allowing two hits and three runs in 2/3 of an inning (5/10) ... Walked four, allowed five hits and nine runs to fall to 3-1 this season in a loss against Washington State (5/4) ... Earned his third win, going a season-high 7 2/3 innings, allowing just two hits and two runs while striking out seven against Arizona (4/26) ... Picked up his second win of the season after limiting Arizona State to three hits and a run while striking out five in six full innings (4/19) ... Worked six full innings against Stanford, scattering five hits and three runs but did not earn the decision (4/12) ... Made his first appearance in relief in more than a month and faced the minimum four batters, striking out one in the process, in 1 1/3 innings against California (4/6) ... Made his second start in his third appearance of the season, going three innings against Portland, striking out three while walking two (3/31) ... Started for the first time against Portland, working a set three innings for his first career win (3/4) ... Made his collegiate debut against Vanderbilt, going 4.2 innings with five strikeouts, four walks and four runs allowed in relief (2/22).
