Oregon State opens its last series of the regular season Friday night against Arizona. First pitch is scheduled for 5:30 p.m. PT.

Last Game

Stefen Romero's run-scoring single in the fifth proved to be the game winner as the Oregon State baseball team closed out its regular season non-conference schedule with a 2-1 victory over No. 21 Oregon in front of 8,487 fans at PGE Park Wednesday night. Romero drove in Jared Norris, who started off the inning with a walk and then moved to second on a wild pitch. The run came off Oregon reliever Christian Jones, who gave up both of OSU's runs in 1 1/3 innings of relief.

Last Series

The series has postseason implications as OSU is tied for eighth, just a game behind sixth-place Arizona. The Beavers carry an unofficial RPI of 28 into the game while the Wildcats are 21st.

Last 10

OSU's bats have come alive as of late, propelling the Beavers to a 6-4 mark over their last 10 games. The Beavers are batting .316 with a .520 slugging percentage over the last 10.

Santos, Too

Adalberto Santos has an 11-game hit streak, which is impressive. Even more impressive is that he is hitting .440 (22-for-50) during it.

2010 (Junior)

Took the loss after allowing 13 hits and eight runs in six innings against Arizona State (5/21) ... Picked up his first win in a month after allowing six hits and four runs in 5 2/3 innings against Washington (5/14) ... Worked 7 1/3 innings, throwing a quality start after scattering five hits and a run with four strikeouts, but did not get the decision against Oregon (5/7) ... Took the loss after allowing 11 hits and seven earned runs over 5 2/3 innings at California (4/30) ... Threw a quality start, but took the loss after allowing nine hits and three earned runs in seven innings against Washington State (4/23) ... Allowed 10 hits and five runs in 6 1/3 innings against Stanford but did not earn a decision (4/16) ... Threw his second complete game of the season, scattering just two hits and a run while striking out six to get the win against No. 3 UCLA (4/9) ... Went seven full innings against USC, but did not pick up the decision after allowing three hits, a run, three walks and 10 strikeouts (4/1) ... Scattered four hits and a run in 4 2/3 innings against Long Beach State, but was removed before earning the win due to a rain delay (3/26) ... Picked up his second win after limiting Maine to six hits and two runs over six innings (3/19) ... Allowed five hits and four runs over 6 1/3 innings against Utah but did not get the decision (3/13) ...
