### The Game

Oregon State opens up NCAA Regional play Friday against Texas A&M. First pitch from Lupton Stadium in Fort Worth, Texas is scheduled for 12 p.m. PT (2 p.m. in Texas).

### Last Game

Oregon State wrapped up its regular season by defeating Stanford, 5-2, on Sunday in California. Tyler Waldron improved to 6-3 this season after going 6 2/3 innings against the Cardinal, scattering five hits and two runs. Koa Kahalehoe drove in two with a bases-clearing double in the seventh.

### Pat Casey Postseason

Oregon State head coach Pat Casey has a 27-6 (.818) record in the postseason, easily leading the program in wins. Prior to Casey's arrival, the Beavers had a 5-12 record in six previous NCAA Tournament appearances.

### Last 10 Games

The last 15 games are often cited by the NCAA selection committee as important when the tournament field is selected. The Beavers left nothing to chance this season, going 10-5 in their last 15. OSU's pitchers posted a 3.75 ERA during that stretch.

### Neutral Site

OSU played in 14 neutral site games in the regular season, going 10-4. Of those 14, five came at PGE Park in Portland, Ore. The Beavers won their last three neutral site games.

### Notes Of Importance


- NCAA statistical rankings prior to the tournament were released on Tuesday. Oregon State has a number of statistics worth noting. They are:
  - 3rd - hits allowed per nine innings (7.84)
  - 7th - earned run average (3.69)
  - 11th - fielding percentage (.976)
  - 11th - sacrifice bunts (59)
  - 18th - walks overall (283)
  - 32nd - winning percentage (.673)
- The Beavers enter Friday's game with a 20-5 overall record in non-conference games this season. OSU has won 12 straight non-league games.
- Oregon State is 10-6 against left-handed starters this season. The Beavers are coming off a 5-2 win against Stanford on Sunday with lefty Brett Mooneyham starting.
- OSU has gone 4-1 in its last five games with its pitchers posting a 2.45 ERA and .188 batting average against.

#### 2009 (Freshman)

Went 9-1, setting an OSU record for most wins in a freshman season ... Posted an ERA of 2.84 in 17 appearances, five of which were starts ... Struck out 49 and walked just seven in 57 innings ... Won his last six decisions ... Won his ninth game of the season after throwing a complete-game shutout against Stanford, striking out seven while allowing three hits (5/22) ... Started against Washington State and earned the win after going 7 2/3 innings, limiting WSU to four hits and two runs while striking out four (5/16) ... Picked up win No. 7 by going five full against Portland, posting seven strikeouts (5/5) ... Started his second career game and went five full innings for his sixth win of the season in OSU's victory over Oregon (4/28) ... Picked up his fifth win of the season after going four full innings in relief, striking out five while allowing five hits and three runs against BYU (4/13) ... earned victory No. 4 after allowing a run and a hit in two innings in the extra-innings win over California (4/5) ... Picked up victory No. 3 after going five innings in a start against Saint Mary's (3/22) ... Earned win No. 2 of his career against UC Riverside, pitching 4 2/3 innings in relief and allowing a run and four hits (3/7) ... Picked up his first career save after a full inning of work against San Francisco (3/5).

#### Ashland

Lettered three seasons for head coach Don Senestrero ... Named the 5A Pitcher of the Year in Oregon his senior season ... Finished senior season with a 13-0 record and led Ashland to the 5A State Championship ... Had a 37-inning scoreless streak against snapped in the state playoffs his senior year ... Named the Southern Sky Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2008 ... Ended senior season with 108 strikeouts and an ERA of approximately 0.50 ... Selected in the 40th round of the 2008 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by Tampa Bay ... Also lettered two seasons in football as a safety where he earned All-Conference honors as a senior and second-team honors as a junior.
