Last Game

Carter Bell and Koa Kahalehoe both posted three hits and Sam Gaviglio picked up his 10th win of the season in Oregon State's 9-8 victory over Texas A&M Friday afternoon. Kahalehoe drove in three, including two insurance runs in the sixth. Bell, meanwhile, doubled in two in the fourth and finished with a career-high three hits. Gaviglio picked up the win after allowing six hits and a run over 5 2/3 innings.

Good NCAA Regional Vibes

With the win Friday, the Beavers have now won their last four NCAA Regional opening games. In their last three NCAA Regionals, the Beavers are 2-1 in their second game.

Back In A One-Run Game

The Beavers' win in the one-run game Friday put OSU at 7-8 in such games this season, and snapped a four-game losing streak in that area. The Beavers are 3-1 in neutral site one-run games. The one-run win was OSU's first since May 2.

Koa Comes Up Big

Koa Kahalehoe posted his first three NCAA post-season hits after going 0-for-2 in eight previous games.

 - 32nd - winning percentage (.673)
- Oregon State starter Tyler Waldron is 2-1 with a 3.75 ERA in six road starts this season. The Beavers are the road team Saturday because TCU is the host team.
- The Beavers, however, are the home club on Saturday because NCAA Regional rules attempt to balance home and visitor appearances in the playoffs.

2009 (Sophomore)

Went 6-3 in 15 appearances, including 13 starts ... Posted an ERA of 3.84 in 89 innings ... Struck out 66 while walking just 28 ... Finished the regular season by holding Stanford to five hits and two runs with five strikeouts in 6 2/3 innings (5/24) ... Won his fifth game of the season after scattering five hits and no runs in 7 1/3 innings against Oregon (5/19) ... Went a full nine against Gonzaga, scattering two hits and a run in a win (5/12) ... Took the loss after allowing 10 hits and six runs in five innings at UCLA (4/24) ... Picked up his first loss in more than a month despite allowing five hits and four runs over seven innings against USC (4/17) ... Did not figure in the decision after allowing 11 hits and five runs over six innings against Arizona (4/9) ... Worked 7 2/3 innings against California, allowing eight hits and four runs to pick up his third win of the season (4/3) ... Picked up his second straight win after allowing just one run and five hits over 7 1/3 innings against Oregon (3/27) ... Earned his first career Oregon State victory, going eight innings, allowing three hits and three walks while striking out six against Utah Valley (3/19) ... Went six full innings, allowing nine hits and seven runs but did not figure in the decision against Missouri State (3/13) ... Took the loss after allowing eight hits and seven runs in five innings against Oklahoma State (3/6) ... Struck out six and allowed five hits and three runs but did not figure in the decision against Arizona State (2/28) ... Made his first Oregon State appearance, striking out four while allowing six hits in 5.0 innings against Tennessee (2/21).

Pacific

Played one season for Pacific, located in Stockton, Calif. ... Went 3-7 in 2008, posting a 5.20 earned run average ... Started all 15 games he appeared in and worked a team-leading 91 2/3 innings ... Struck out 63 ... Appeared against Oregon State in the final game of the season, and limited the Beavers to just five hits and two runs over seven innings while striking out five.

Golden Sierra High

During his tenure at Golden Sierra, was a four-year all-league performer and two-time Most Valuable Player for the Grizzlies ... Was also named the Sacramento Player of the Year in 2007 ... Posted a 0.65 earned run average as a senior, allowing just seven earned runs in 76 innings ... Finished with 151 strikeouts to just 17 walks as a senior ... Offensively, as a senior, hit .530 with 12 doubles, two triples and two home runs ... Had a 7-2 record and 1.13 ERA as a junior ... During the summer of 2006 he was a member of the Milwaukee Brewers Area Code Team.
