Oregon State and Florida meet in the Beavers' second game of the Gainesville Regional Saturday night at 7 p.m. ET (4 p.m. PT).

Last Game

Tyler Smith hit his first home run in two months and Greg Peavey allowed two hits over 6 1/3 innings to pace the Oregon State baseball team past Florida Atlantic, 6-4, in the opening game of the Gainesville Regional Friday afternoon at McKethan Stadium. The Beavers held on for the two-run win after the Owls scored four runs late in the game to make it interesting. However, Oregon State's offensive attack, which provided Peavey with 10 hits, proved to be enough.

The Winner Gets Good Position

The winner of Saturday's game advances to the regional's title game, which will be held at 7 p.m. ET Sunday. The loser must play at 1 p.m., will have to win to advance to the title game.

Against The SEC

OSU will meet Florida for the first time in school history, but the Beavers are no stranger to the Southeastern Conference. OSU has played at least one game against an SEC team every year since 2006, going 7-3 in those games.

Notes Of Importance

- The trip to Gainesville was approximately 3,000 miles for Oregon State. That, however, was not the longest trip for the club. The Beavers opened the 2010 season at Hawaii.
- Oregon State finished the regular season with an average home attendance of 2,090 over 31 dates, which put the Beavers 29th nationally and third among all Pac-10 clubs.
- Andrew Susac extended his hit streak to six games Friday, and tallied two hits for a multiple-hit game, of which he has six this season. Three of those six have come in his last six games.
- Head coach Pat Casey won his 30th postseason game at Oregon State Friday. He is 30-8 (.789) in five postseason appearances.
- The Beavers are 17-4 when getting a quality start from its starting pitcher. OSU is 4-0 in neutral-site games when doing so.
- The Beavers are 23-8 when scoring the game's first run and is 29-7 when it holds its opponent to five runs or less.

Didn't get a decision after scattering four hits and four runs in 5 2/3 innings against Arizona State (5/22) ... Threw 7 2/3 innings against Washington, allowing five hits and three runs but took the loss (5/16) ... Went 8 2/3 innings against Oregon in a quality start, but did not get the decision after allowing 10 hits and three unearned runs (5/9) ... Took the loss to fall to 2-2 after allowing six hits and eight runs at California (5/2) ... Improved to 2-1 and made his first quality start of the season in allowing just five hits and a run in 6 2/3 innings against Washington State (4/25) ... Took the loss after allowing eight hits and nine runs in 2 2/3 innings against Stanford (4/18) ... Scattered six hits and two runs over 4 2/3 innings against UCLA but did not get the decision (4/11) ... Started his first game of the season and struck out four while allowing two runs and four hits to get the win in 5 1/3 innings against USC (4/3) ...
