2010 (Junior)

Appeared in 23 games, all in relief ... Went 2-2 with a 3.13 ERA in 31 2/3 innings ... Saved four games ... Picked up save No. 4 after a scoreless ninth against Oregon (5/26) ... Earned his third save after 1 2/3 innings of scoreless relief against Washington (5/14) ... Won his second game of the season in extras against Oregon, limiting the Ducks to two hits in 2 1/3 innings while striking out five (5/7) ... Picked up save No. 2 after allowing two hits and a run over 1 1/3 innings at Washington State (4/25) ... Earned the win after throwing 1 1/3 innings of scoreless relief against USC (4/1) ... Threw 2 1/3 scoreless innings against Maine, striking out one and allowing one hit (3/21) ... Struck out five in 2 innings of work against Maine (3/20) ... Worked 1 2/3 scoreless innings against UC Riverside (3/4) ... Struck out three in 1 1/3 innings to earn his first save of the season, it coming against Hawaii (2/20).

2009 (Sophomore)

Saved nine games, posting a 3-3 record and 4.18 ERA in the process ... Worked 23 2/3 innings in 23 appearances, striking out 33 ... Went 3-1 with a 2.45 ERA in nine Pac-10 appearances ... Saved two games ... Saved the season finale against Stanford, striking out one in one inning (5/24) ... Struck out one in a scoreless ninth to record his eighth save of the season, coming against Oregon (5/19) ... Struck out two in 1 1/3 innings against Washington for his seventh save of the season (5/8) ... Struck out a season-high four while throwing a season-high 2 1/3 innings for the win in the series finale against Arizona State (5/3) ... Earned win No. 2 this season after holding UCLA scoreless over a season-high 1 2/3 innings (4/25) ... Picked up his first career win after needing just four pitches to record an out in the series finale against USC (4/19) ... Earned save No. 5 after a scoreless inning against BYU (4/13) ... Struck out three in an inning of work in a non-save situation against Oregon (3/29) ... Came on in a mop up role against Saint Mary's and got three strikeouts in an inning (3/22) ... Posted saved No. 14 against Northern Illinois (3/1).

2008 (Freshman)

NCBWA Freshman All-America First Team ... Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-America Team ... Baseball America Freshman All-America Second Team ... Ping! Baseball Freshman All-America ... All-Pac-10 Honorable Mention ... Finished the season with 20 appearances, all coming in relief ... Saved 12 games while posting an 0-1 record with a 2.39 ERA ... Worked 26 1/3 innings, striking out 32 ... Was 12-for-14 in save opportunities ... Did not allow a hit until his seventh appearance of the season and a run until his 11th ... Inherited 14 runners, allowing five to score (36 percent) ... Appeared in nine Pac-10 games, going 0-1 with a 2.45 ERA ... Saved four Pac-10 games ... The 12 saves ties him for the third-best single-season OSU record ... Closed out his 11th game of the season after walking one and striking out one in an inning in the series finale against UCLA (5/11) ... Struck out two and pitched a perfect ninth against Portland to earn his 10th save of the season (5/7) ... Closed out his ninth save of the season by going one full inning, allowing a hit and two walks with two strikeouts against Arizona (4/27) ... Pitched 1 1/3 innings against Arizona, allowing two hits and a run, to earn his seventh save of the season (4/26) ... Moved to a perfect 7-for-7 in save opportunities this season after striking out two with one walk and a hit in the ninth against Arizona

State (4/18) ... Worked one full inning against California, allowing just a hit while striking out one (4/6) ... Needed just 30 pitches to go 3 1/3 innings against Portland, striking out five while not allowing a baserunner (3/31) ... Posted his sixth save of the season after going 1 2/3 innings against BYU (3/25) ... Earned saves in both games of a doubleheader against Pepperdine, working a combined 2 1/3 innings, striking out four and walking one (3/21) ... Worked a perfect ninth against Santa Clara for his third save of the season (3/9) ... Picked up his second save against Georgia, going one full inning and striking out two in his third appearance of the season against Georgia (3/2) ... Picked up his first career save against Georgia, walking one in an inning (2/29).

Horizon High

Lettered three years for head coach Eric Kisler ... three-time all-region member and earned all-state twice ... was an All-American his senior year and played for Team USA for two years ... went 9-1 with a 1.14 ERA and 117 strikeouts in helping guide Horizon to a state championship his senior year ... was 7-3 with a 2.03 ERA and 96 strikeouts as a junior ... as a sophomore, guided Horizon to a state championship after going 9-2 with a 1.92 ERA and 104 strikeouts.
