2010 (Junior)

Named Pacific-10 Conference Pitcher of the Week on March 22 ... Made 14 appearances, all starts ... Went 5-4 with a 3.43 ERA in 76 innings ... Did not earn a decision after allowing four hits and four runs over three innings at Arizona State (5/23) ... Earned his fifth win of the season, and first in almost two months, after allowing five hits and a run in 5 2/3 innings against Washington (5/15) ... Did not get the decision after scattering two hits with three strikeouts in 3 2/3 innings against Oregon (5/8) ... Did not get a decision after allowing four hits and four runs over 4 2/3 innings at California (5/1) ... Took the loss after allowing nine hits and 11 runs in 3 2/3 innings against Washington State (4/24) ... Threw his fifth quality start of the season, but did not get a decision after scattering eight hits and three runs in 7 1/3 innings against Stanford (4/17) ... Worked 6 1/3 innings against UCLA, allowing five hits and a run but did not get the decision (4/10) ... Dropped to 4-3 on the year after allowing four hits and three runs in 4 1/3 innings at USC (4/2) ... Took the loss after allowing seven hits and four runs over six innings against Long Beach State (3/27) ... Struck out a career-best 12 and limited Maine to two hits and one unearned run in eight innings for the win (3/20) ... Scattered four hits and two runs over 6 2/3 innings while striking out two to get the win against Portland (3/14) ... Picked up win No. 2 by holding Utah Valley to no runs and nine hits while striking out nine in 7 2/3 innings (3/6) ... Went 3 2/3 innings, allowing five hits and two runs while striking out three against Tennessee, taking the loss (2/27) ... Held Hawaii to six hits and three runs in 5 1/3 innings while striking out three for his first win of the season (2/20).

2009 (Sophomore)

Worked in nine games, including eight starts ... Finished the regular season 1-3 with a 4.75 ERA, striking out 31 in 36 innings ... Went 3 2/3 innings against TCU, striking out four while allowing two hits and a run (5/31) ... Took the loss after working in relief against Stanford, going three full innings, striking out seven while walking three (5/23) ... Dropped to 1-2 on the year after allowing eight hits and six runs in three innings at Washington State (5/15) ... Earned his first win of the season after allowing Washington to two hits and a walk in 6 1/3 innings at Safeco Field (5/8) ... Took the loss after allowing three earned runs while striking out six in five innings against Arizona State (5/1) ... Made his fourth appearance of the year, scattering four hits and a run over three innings against BYU (4/14) ... Worked three innings against UC Riverside, walking four and allowing one hit (3/7) ... Scattered two hits and three runs in four innings against Missouri (3/7) ... Served as Oregon State's opening day starter and allowed three hits and three runs over five innings at Tennessee (2/20).

2008 (Freshman)

Finished his first campaign with OSU with a 3-2 record and 6.31 ERA ... Made 10 appearances, eight of which were starts ... Worked 35 2/3 innings, striking out 28 while opponents hit .219 against him ... Was 2-1 with a 6.65 ERA in six Pac-10 appearances ... Dropped to 3-2 on the year after allowing seven hits and six runs in two innings against Long Beach State (5/19) ... Started against UCLA and did not get a decision after allowing two hits and three runs in 2/3 of an inning (5/10) ... Walked four, allowed five hits and nine runs to fall to 3-1 this season in a loss against Washington State (5/4) ... Earned his third win, going a season-high 7

2/3 innings, allowing just two hits and two runs while striking out seven against Arizona (4/26) ... Picked up his second win of the season after limiting Arizona State to three hits and a run while striking out five in six full innings (4/19) ... Worked six full innings against Stanford, scattering five hits and three runs but did not earn the decision (4/12) ... Made his first appearance in relief in more than a month and faced the minimum four batters, striking out one in the process, in 1 1/3 innings against California (4/6) ... Made his second start in his third appearance of the season, going three innings against Portland, striking out three while walking two (3/31) ... Started for the first time against Portland, working a set three innings for his first career win (3/4) ... Made his collegiate debut against Vanderbilt, going 4.2 innings with five strikeouts, four walks and four runs allowed in relief (2/22).

Lettered four years for head coach John Hoover ... selected in the 14th round of the 2007 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim but did not sign ... ranked No. 40 among 2007 Major League Baseball Draft Top 50 Prospects (high school and college) by Baseball America magazine ... ranked No. 10 among Area Code Games Top 20 Prospects by Baseball America magazine in 2006 ... selected to play in 2006 Aflac All-American High School Baseball Classic ... earned state Most Valuable Player honors his sophomore, junior and senior seasons ... All-American senior year and team captain ... finished high school career 33-0 ... went 10-0 as a senior, posting 109 strikeouts in 50 innings ... was 9-0 as a junior, finishing with 146 strikeouts in 62 innings ... as a sophomore, ended the season with an 8-0 record, accumulating 89 strikeouts in 46 innings ... started off his high school career with a 6-0 record as a freshman.
