Appeared in and started 43 games ... Batted .326 with 10 doubles, a triple and 13 home runs while driving in 41 ... Was 2-for-3 and drove in the game-winning run in the fifth against Oregon (5/26) ... Hit his third home run in four games and extended his hit streak to 10 games by going 2-for-3 against San Diego (5/10) ... Went 2-for-3, walked twice and scored the winning run against Oregon (5/9) ... lubbed his 11th home run of the season, a two-run shot, in the first inning against Oregon, and got two walks intentionally twice (5/8) ... Hit his 10th home run of the season, a solo shot, against Oregon (5/7) ... Tied a season-high by going 3-for-5 with two doubles at Oregon (4/27) ... Went 2-for-5 with an RBI against Washington State (4/25) ... Stroked a three-run home run in the third against Stanford (4/17) ... Hit his seventh home run of the season in the sixth against UCLA (4/11) ... Was 3-for-4 with three RBI and a home run against Long Beach State (3/26) ... Combined to go 5-for-7 with three RBI and a home run in a doubleheader against Maine (3/20) ... Hit his fourth home run of the season against Maine (3/19) ... Tripled home a run in the win over Utah (3/13) ... Finished 2-for-4 with two runs, an RBI and a double against Utah Valley (3/6) ... Went 2-for-4 with a double and scored two runs against Tennessee (2/26) ... Hit his second home run of the season and went 2-for-4 against Hawaii (2/21) ... Opened the season by going 3-for-4 with three runs, a home run, two doubles and four RBI at Hawaii (2/19).

2009 (Sophomore)

Played in and started in 55 games in his first season with the Beavers, batting .291 with 18 doubles, three triples and five home runs ... Drove in 51 ... In Pac-10 games, hit .274 with six doubles, three triples and two home runs ... Drove in 18 against league opponents ... Drove in three in the season finale against TCU (5/31) ... Hit a home run and went 2-for-5 against Stanford (5/23) ... Doubled home two runs and went 2-for-5 with a run against Oregon (5/20) ... Extended his hit streak to six games by going 2-for-3 with two runs, an RBI and two walks against Gonzaga (5/12) ... Tripled home three runs and went 2-for-5 with two runs scored against Washington (5/8) ... Went 2-for-4 with a run scored against Arizona State (5/1) ... Hit a home run and drove in three against UCLA (4/24) ... Extended his hit streak to five games while walking twice and doubling in the series finale against USC (4/19) ... Drove in the game-tying run in the 11th and went 3-for-5 with an RBI against California (4/5) ... Moved his hit streak to four games with a 2-for-4 effort with three RBI against Oregon (3/29) ... Finished 2-for-5 with an RBI and a double against Oregon (3/28) ... Went 2-for-5 and drove in three runs against Utah Valley (3/20) ... Hit third home run of the season and was 2-for-5 against Missouri State (3/13) ... Went 2-for-5 with a double and drove in two runs against Texas Tech (3/8) ... Drove in two with two hits against Oklahoma State (3/6) ... Hit safely for the fifth straight game, going 1-for-4 with a double and two RBI against Arizona State (2/28) ... Drove in four and collected three hits, including two doubles, against Missouri (2/27) ... Went 3-for-4 with four runs, three RBI, two walks, a double and a home run against Northern Illinois (2/26) ... Hit OSU's first home run and drove in three overall against Tennessee (2/21) ... Opened his Oregon State career by going 1-for-3 with a run scored against Tennessee (2/20).
