All-Pac-10 First Team ... Named Pacific-10 Conference Player of the Week on May 31 ... Appeared in and started all 56 games ... Batted .336 with 15 doubles, four triples, 10 home runs, 36 RBI and 20 stolen bases ... Posted two two-run home runs and finished with three runs scored and two stolen bases in a 3-for-3 effort against Arizona (5/28) ... Hit a home run for the second straight game and was 3-for-5 with two runs and two RBI against Arizona State (5/23) ... Extended his hit streak to nine games and hit a two-run home run in the eighth against Arizona State (5/22) ... Hit a leadoff home run and went 3-for-4 with two runs and three RBI against Seattle (5/18) ... Doubled, went 1-for-4 and drove in two against Washington (5/15) ... Was 4-for-5 and drove in two runs against Washington (5/14) ... Went 2-for-3 with two runs and a walk against Oregon (5/8) ... Extended his hit streak to five games by going 2-for-4 against Washington State (4/25) ... Went 3-for-4 and tripled twice while scoring three runs against Portland (4/6) ... Homered and went 1-for-1 with two runs, two RBI, and a home run against Southern Utah (3/24) ... Went 1-for-4 with a solo home run, the game winner, in the series finale against Maine (3/21) ... Went 2-for-3 with three runs scored and two stolen bases against Maine (3/20) ... Moved his hit streak to four games by going 2-for-4 with an RBI against Portland (3/14) ... Hit his first home run of the season and went 2-for-3 with three RBI to extend his hit streak to three games against Portland (3/13) ... Went 3-for-5 with two RBI and two stolen bases in a win over Hawaii (2/20).

All-Pac-10 Honorable Mention ... Ended season having played in 53 games, including 47 starts ... Batted .320 with six doubles, two triples and four home runs ... Drove in 43, third on the team ... Played in 25 Pac-10 games, starting 21 ... Against league opponents, batted .282 with two doubles, two home runs and 16 RBI ... Went 3-for-4 with two RBI in the season finale against TCU (5/31) ... Walked twice and went 1-for-4 with two runs scored against Texas A&M (5/31) ... Finished the Oregon season series finale 2-for-4 with two runs, three RBI and two walks (5/20) ... Hit two home runs and finished 3-for-4 with two RBI in the series opener against Washington State (5/15) ... Doubled home three runs against Washington (5/9) ... Finished the Arizona State series going 2-for-4 with a run scored and the game-winning RBI (5/3) ... Went 2-for-4 with an RBI and a walk against Arizona State (5/2) ... Drove in a run on a sac fly in the ninth against Arizona State (5/1) ... Scored the game-winning run in the 11th against California and went 1-for-3 with two walks and two runs scored (4/5) ... Drove in two, walked twice and went 1-for-2 in the series finale against Oregon (3/29) ... Moved his hit streak to 13 games by going 1-for-3 against Hawai'i (3/23) ...
