Oregon State (11-19, 5-13) vs. No. 16 Arizona (25-6, 14-4) March 10, 2011 • 2:30 p.m. MT • Staples Center • Los Angeles, Calif.

THE GAME: Oregon State will play the No. 16 Arizona Wildcats in the quarterfinals of the Pac-10 Tournament at 2:30 p.m. on March 10 at the Staples Center in Los Angeles, Calif., in a game televised nationally on FSN.

QUICKLY: Oregon State defeated Stanford on Wednesday for its first Pac-10 Tournament win since 2006 ... Sophomores and freshmen combined for 67 of the Beavers 69 points in the win over Stanford ... The Beavers have won three of the past four games against Arizona ... The Beavers are now 10-1 on the season when leading with five minutes to play ... Devon Collier has 21 blocked shots on the season and broke Gary Payton's freshman record of 20 blocked shots set in 1986-87 ... Ahmad Starks has made 38 three-pointers this season, the third most by a freshman in Oregon State history (trailing Angelo Tsagarakis, 45 and Joe See, 43) ... Jared Cunningham has 79 steals on the season and broke Oregon State's sophomore steals record of 72 set by Gary Payton in 1987-88 ... Freshman Roberto Nelson had a career-high 34 points against Arizona State, it's just the third since 2000 that an Oregon State player has scored 30+ points in a game ... Senior Omari Johnson has four double-doubles and has led the team in rebounding 17 times this season.

vs. ARIZONA: Oregon State and Arizona split the season series with the Beavers winning 76-75 on Jan. 2 at Gill Coliseum and the Wildcats winning 70-59 on March 3 at the McKale Center. Arizona holds a 20-52 advantage in the series and the Beavers have won three of the past four games.

Oregon and Arizona have played four times previously in the Pac-10 Tournament and the Wildcats have won all four meetings. The results are listed below (with seedings in parenthesis):

The winner of the Oregon State-Arizona quarterfinals game will play the winner of the No. 4 seed USC Trojans vs. No. 5 seed California Golden Bears at 6 p.m. on Friday at the Staples Center.

PAC-10 TOURNAMENT NOTES:

- The Beavers are the No. 9 seed and Arizona is the No. 1 seed in this year's quarterfinals matchup.
- Oregon State is 6-11 in tournament games and Arizona is 17-9 with four Pac-10 Tournament titles.
- The No. 9 seed is 0-4 vs. the No. 1 seed all-time in tournament games.
- The No. 9 seed is 5-9 all-time in tournament games.
- Gary Payton is the lone Oregon State player to be named to the All-Tournament team (1988 and 1989).

OREGON STATE vs. STANFORD PAC-10 TOURNAMENT OPENING GAME NOTES

Team Notes

- Oregon State won its first Pac-10 Tournament game since defeating Arizona State, 71-68, on March 8, 2006.
- The Beavers are now 6-11 all-time in Pac-10 Tournament games.
- Oregon State sophomores and freshmen combined to score 67 of the Beavers 69 points.
- The Beavers had 58 of their 69 points off the bench.
- Oregon State is now 10-1 this season when leading with five minutes to play.
- The Beavers held Stanford to an opponent first half season-low 18 points. The previous opponent first half low was 19 by Illinois-Chicago (12/22/10).

Player Notes

- With two blocked shots in the game, freshman Devon Collier has 21 on the season and broke Oregon State's freshman blocked shots record of 20 set by Gary Payton in 1986-87.
- Collier had a career-high 19 points (previous high 16 vs. Washington State on 2/5/11). He also had career-highs in free throws made (7) and free throws attempted (11).
- Sophomore Joe Burton had a career-high 14 rebounds (previous high was 12 at UCLA on 2/25/10). It's his first double-figure rebounding game of the season.
- Burton has played 77 minutes combined the past two games (39 vs. Arizona State and 38 vs. Stanford).
- Burton tied a career-high with three steals.
- Sophomore Jared Cunningham tied a career-high with 24 points.
- Cunningham tied a career-high with 15 free throws made and had a career-high with 20 free throws attempted. Both are Pac-10 Tournament records.

STARTING LINEUPS: The Beavers have used 10 different starting lineups this season, including the current starting lineup of Roberto Nelson at guard, Omari Johnson, Kevin McShane and Joe Burton at forward and Angus Brandt at center.
