

Malcolm Agnew (35) exploded onto the scene in his college debut against Sacramento State in 2011 rushing for 233 yards and three touchdowns. Agnew's 233-yard performance is the ninth-best in OSU history and tops the list among freshmen.

2012: Malcolm returns for his second season and plans to pick up where he left off prior to a hamstring injury that limited his availability for several weeks in 2011 . . . he'll vie with several other returning backs to be the primary ballcarrier . . . possesses good hands, excellent balance and vision. 2011: Won the starting tailback spot in fall camp . . . one of 10 true freshmen to play in 2011, an Oregon State record . . . became the first true freshman in modern history to start the season opener at running back at OSU . . . rushed into the record books in his collegiate debut with 33 carries for 223 yards and three touchdowns against Sacramento State – an OSU freshman record and ninth-best rushing performance in OSU history . . . earned College Football Performance Awards honorable mention following the season opener . . . pulled his right hamstring in practice leading up to game 2 and missed next four games (Wisconsin, UCLA, Arizona State and Arizona) . . . returned to play against BYU, then started next four games . . finished the season as the Beavers' leading rusher with 423 yards and tied for a team-high five rushing touchdowns.

DE SMET JESUIT: Two-year starter at cornerback and running back ... 28-8 record as a member of the varsity team for three years (state semifinals as a junior and senior) ... Rivals ranked him the 45th best running back prospect in the nation ... two-year team captain ... two-time All-Metro Catholic Conference (6A) running back ... all-state cornerback as a junior ... rushed for 904 yards and 17 touchdowns as a junior, and 505 yards and seven touchdowns in an injury-shortened senior season ... four-year varsity track member (sprinter) where is was among the fastest in the state in the 100 and 200 meters.

PERSONAL: Born May 17, 1993 in Winston-Salem, North Carolina ... son of Ray Agnew Jr., and Kathy Agnew ... Ray is former 11-year NFL veteran (Patriots, Giants and Rams) and currently serves as a scout for the Rams – he played college football at North Carolina State ... has two siblings, Ray III and Keenan ... Ray III is a junior running back at Southern Illinois University ... honor roll student at De Smet Jesuit with a 3.50 cumulative GPA and was named one of the school's Men of the Year for 2011 ... chose OSU because "I felt at home the instant I visited and I like Coach (Mike) Riley and his beliefs. I also like the pro-style offense and I know I will get a good education." ... studying new media communication.


