# Beavers to Make First NCAA Championships Appearance Since 2000-01

## THE TOURNAMENT & COURSE

The Oregon State men's golf team is heading to The Honors Course in Ooltewah, Tenn. and hosted by Chattanooga to compete at the NCAA Division I Men's Golf Championships. The Honors Course in Ooltewah, Tenn. is a par-72 course that will play approximately 7,395 yards.

"It's a big day for the program to finally get back (to nationals)," head coach Brian Watts said. "The guys have worked extremely hard. It's well deserved. We're looking forward to getting back there. The season is a long way from over, and we've got goals that we want to accomplish when we get there."

The NCAA Championships are a six day event. The first three days consist of a 54-hole tournament with 18-hole rounds played each day, June 1-3. The top eight finishers will advance to match-play with teams pitted head-to-head in a single elimination tournament for the national championship.

"(The regional tournament at) Gold Mountain was great preparation for us, because other than the hills, the courses are relatively set up the same. There is quite a bit of rough, basically we'll need to keep it in the fairway ... and the greens are big enough to hit a lot of green, and if our putters are working, then I think we'll have a good shot."

## PREVIOUS TOURNAMENT

The Beavers placed fourth at the NCAA Gold Mountain Regional in Bremerton, Wash. OSU stood fifth going into the final round and needed maintain their standing in order to advance to nationals. The Beavers received rounds of 1-under 71 from sophomores Morten Madsen and Alex Moore. Moore led the Beavers for the tournament with a (73-77-71) 221.

## BEEN THERE ... WELL, CLOSE ANYWAY

Although the Beavers haven't been to The Honors Course, they are familiar with the Tennessee area. In October, Oregon State tied for first at the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate hosted by East Tennessee State at The Ridges Golf and Country Club in Jonesborough - Tennessee was given the win after all five scorecards were counted. Diego Velasquez finished the tournament at 10-under par to win by an impressive seven strokes.

"The whole intent of going to Tennessee in the fall was because we knew the national championships were going to be in Tennessee," Watts said. "The experience that these guys had in the fall, winning a huge tournament - and with Diego winning the tournament - you would hope that the guys would feed off of that. We're going to definitely use that to our advantage."

## REPRESENTING THE PAC-10 CONFERENCE

It is common knowledge in the college golf world that the Pac-10 Conference is one of, if not the, premier conferences in the country. In 2010, eight teams from the Conference of Champions will hit the links at the NCAA Championships. To further illustrating the point, a Pac-10 school - Washington, Oregon, Stanford and UCLA - was the No. 1 seed at four of the six NCAA Regionals.

## RECORD SEASON

The Beavers have been re-writing the record books all season long as four golfers have climbed into the top 10 lists on numerous Beaver records. The team has also been ranked in the top 25 nationally for virtually the entire season. The team tied for first place at the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate, with Diego Velasquez finishing as the top individual, winning by an unheard of seven strokes. Velasquez and Mike Barry both reach the top five for a low individual score in 4 rounds with Velasquez at 4-under 280 (third) and Barry at 3-under 281 (fifth), both scores recorded at the Pac-10 Championships. Morten Madsen and Barry each had single rounds of 6-under 65s, which is one stroke off of the school record 64 held by Tim Mickelson, set in the Spring of 2000. This is the fourth year in a row that the Beavers will head to an NCAA Regional. This is the first time the Beavers have qualified for nationals since 2001, where they finished in 12th.

## HEAD COACH

Brian Watts is in his 10th year as the Beavers head coach, and his 13th overall with the program. He was an assistant coach for the men's and women's teams from 1995-97 and 1999-01. He has led the Beavers to back-to-back fifth place finishes at the Pac-10 Championships and to third in 2002. OSU has reached the postseason in each of the last four years and are playing in the 2010 NCAA Championships for the first time during Watts' tenure.

In September of 2007 the Oregon State men and women's golf teams started a new tradition with the inaugural Giustina Memorial Classic held at Trysting Tree Golf Club.

The classic is named after Natale B. "Nat" Giustina, who played a fundamental role in the creation of Trysting Tree Golf Club. The Oregon State alumnus was a prominent figure in the OSU community, serving on the OSU Alumni Association board and the Board of Intercollegiate Athletics. The format for the classic is a one of a kind creation by Oregon State men's head coach Brian Watts and women's head coach Rise Lakowske in Nat's honor.

"I think the other schools and players are excited about the format," Lakowske said. "It's a unique way of playing a collegiate tournament. It should provide a lot of interest locally."

The classic plays host to both a men's and women's tournament simultaneously. It matches a mixed pair from each competing school with another school's mixed pair. The men and women's tournament are scored separately but a combined school champion is awarded an overall winning trophy.

"To my knowledge this is the first time that a format like this has been played in collegiate golf. We wanted to do something unique that combined the men's and women's programs together. It is a lot of fun for the players as well as the spectators," Watts said.

For the men's golf team the creation of the Giustina Memorial sees the end to the Northwest Collegiate Classic which was the home tournament for the Beavers for the previous 17 years. Over that 17 year history, the tournament was played 18 times in which Oregon State claimed six victories. Since the change in 2007, the men's team has claimed one victory as a team and they combined with the women's team to win two university championships.
