Beavers Advance To NCAA Regionals

Oregon State earned its first trip to the NCAA Regionals since 2006 and will compete at the West Regional at the Colorado National Golf Club in Erie, Colo., from May 10-12 as the No. 18 seed in the 24-team field. The Beavers are one of 72 teams to receive a bid to three regionals (West, Central, East). The top eight teams from each will advance to the NCAA Championships May 22-25 at the Vanderbilt Legends Club in Franklin, Tenn.

This marks Oregon State's 11th appearance in the NCAA Regionals, all under the leadership of 24th-year head coach Risë Alexander, and first since the 2005-06 season when the Beavers finished in 13th place in the 21-team field that competed at the Washington National Golf Club in Auburn, Wash.

Oregon State advanced to the NCAA Regionals nine times in 10 years between 1994 and 2003 (missed in 2002) and had its last invitation in 2006 after a two-year absence in 2004 and 2005. The Beavers tied for 10th place at the Regionals in 1998 when they made their lone trip to the NCAA Championships.

TEAM RECORDS: Oregon State is enjoying one of its best seasons in school history with four top-5 and six top-10 finishes in their 11 tournaments. The Beavers currently have a school-record team stroke average of 76.15 and posted their best round in school history, a 2-under 282 in the second round of the Stanford Intercollegiate in Stanford Calif., in the fall. They also equaled their second-best round in school history with an even-par 288 in the final round of the Pacific Coast Intercollegiate in Half Moon Bay, Calif., in the spring.

BEAVERS' LINEUP: Oregon State will go with a lineup of senior Whitney French, junior Rachael Fischer, sophomores Lauren Sewell and Seshia Telles and freshman Anica Yoo, the same five it has gone with the last seven tournaments.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES: Four of the five golfers have set or equaled their career-best round this season with Telles (-3), French (-2) and Yoo (-2) all shooting subpar rounds. Sewell shot a 3-under 69 last season and added a 1-under 70 this season, while Fischer had a career-low 2-over 74 each of the last two seasons. Telles currently owns the Oregon State career scoring average record (76.10), while French is third on that list (76.94) and tied for second in career rounds played (126).
