



## 2016 NCAA DIVISION I WOMEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

### POSTGAME NOTES – Oregon State

- Fell behind 2-0 before using 11-0 run over 4:48 stretch to secure nine-point lead (11-2).
- Closed out first quarter on 12-0 run (3:10 span) to secure 23-4 lead.
- Allowed fewest points in first half this season – previous low 16 vs. Portland (11/16).
- Ninth time this season that opposing team has scored less than 20 points in first half.
- Opened second half without a point for first three minutes and 15 seconds.
- Closed out third quarter on 8-0 run over span of 4:49 to earn 54-21 lead.
- Senior Ruth Hamblin registered 12<sup>th</sup> double-double of the season, including fifth straight (18 points, 18 rebounds).
- Junior Sydney Wiese registered 10-or-more rebounds for the fifth time this season.
- Wiese registered third double-double this year (10 points & 10 assists).

### POSTGAME NOTES – Troy

- Scored game's first points then went scoreless over 5:09 stretch (0-for-10 from field).
- Started game 1-for-1 then went 1-for-18 to close out first quarter (9:29 stretch).
- Four points in first quarter is lowest of the season (previous low 8 vs. Arkansas State).
- Lowest first half point total of season – previous low was 17 versus Vanderbilt (12/10).
- First half field goals made ties season-low (12/10 versus Vanderbilt).
- First half field goal percentage (16.7% | 6-for-36) is lowest of season.
- Scored first points of each half.
- Went scoreless over final 5:15 of third quarter (0-for-11).
- Lowest point total of the season (previous low 43 vs. Vanderbilt – 12/10).
- Senior Ashley Beverly Kelley ends career with 1,973 points.
- Beverly Kelley made fourth lowest field goals in a game this season (4-for-19).
